The Board of the County Commissioners in and for Garden County, Nebraska, met on February 24, 2025 at the Garden County Courthouse for their regular meeting, pursuant to statute. Notice of the regular meeting was given in advance by publication in the Garden County News on February 19, 2025. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the public.

Chairman Dymak called the meeting to order at 8:31 a.m. with the following members present: Terry Krauter, David Dymak, Dixann Krajewski.

Dymak acknowledged that the Open Meeting Laws are posted on the meeting room wall along with the Garden County Board Meeting Guidelines. Pledge of Allegiance was said.

Motion was made by Krajewski, seconded by Krauter, to approve the consent agenda, which includes Agenda, Minutes of last regular meeting and Board of Equalization held February 10, 2025, claims and payroll by general consent and allow the County Clerk to issue warrants in payment of the claims and payroll. A copy of which is on file in the office of the County Clerk. Roll call vote: Yeas: Dymak, Krajewski, Krauter. Nays: 0. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Krajewski, seconded by Krauter to appoint Sarah Quinn to fill the vacancy on the Panhandle Public Health Board (replace Mary Gentry). Roll call vote: Yeas: Krajewski, Krauter, Dymak. Nays: 0. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Dymak, seconded by Krauter to approve the bid from Aulick Industries in the amount of \$30,000.00 (Informal bids received from Aulick Industries and Bunkhouse Trailer Sales). Roll call vote: Yeas: Krauter, Dymak, Krajewski. Nays: 0. Motion carried.

The Board recessed between 8:45 a.m. and 9:09 a.m. for the quarterly jail visit.

Ross gave the Sheriff report.

The regular meeting was recessed at 9:18 a.m. for the One-Year and Six-Year Road and Highway Improvement Plan Public Hearing. The Public Hearing was published February 12, 2025 and February 19, 2025.

The One-Year and Six-Year Plan was reviewed and discussed. There was no public comment. The Public Hearing was closed at 9:28 a.m.

Motion was made by Krauter, seconded by Dymak to approve Resolution 2025-2-2 for the One-Year and Six-Year Highway Improvement Plan (Published in the Garden County News February 12, 2025 and February 19, 2025 and posted in the Lisco Post Office, Oshkosh Post Office and Lewellen Post Office and Garden County Clerk's Office on February 12, 2025). Roll call vote: Yeas: Krajewski, Krauter, Dymak. Nays: 0. Motion carried.
