Motion was made by Krajewski, seconded by Dymak to approve Resolution 2025-3-2 to transfer \$150,000.00 from Road to Road/Bridge Sinking Fund. Roll call vote: Yeas: Dymak, Krajewski, Krauter. Nays: 0. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Krauter, seconded by Dymak to approve Resolution 2025-3-3 to create the position of Chief Deputy Coroner and to appoint the Garden County Sheriff as Chief Deputy Coroner. Roll call vote: Yeas: Dymak, Krauter, Krajewski Nays: 0 Motion carried.

Dymak adjourned the meeting at 10:19 a.m.
