The Board of the County Commissioners in and for Garden County, Nebraska, met on July 28, 2025 at the Garden County Courthouse for their regular meeting, pursuant to statute. Notice of the regular meeting was given in advance by publication in the Garden County News on July 23, 2025. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the public.

Chairman Dymak called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. with the following members present: Terry Krauter, David Dymak, Dixann Krajewski.

Dymak acknowledged that the Open Meeting Laws are posted on the meeting room wall along with the Garden County Board Meeting Guidelines. Pledge of Allegiance was said.

Motion was made by Krauter, seconded by Krajewski, to approve the consent agenda, which includes Agenda, Minutes of last regular meeting and Board of Equalization held July 14, 2025, minutes of the Special Meeting and Board of Equalization held July 21, 2025, claims and payroll by general consent and allow the County Clerk to issue warrants in payment of the claims and payroll. A copy of which is on file in the office of the County Clerk. Roll call vote: Yeas: Dymak, Krajewski, Krauter. Nays: 0. Motion carried.

Public Comment: Teresa McCormick discussed a road issue and elections.

Leach gave Transportation updates.

Ross gave the Sheriff Report.

Frerichs gave the Road Report. Deb Fischer advanced over \$60 Million to improve infrastructure and firefighting capabilities out of the Appropriations Committee. If it passes the Senate and House, it would include \$5.2 million to replace the Lisco Bridge in Garden County.

Dymak recessed the regular meeting at 9:01 a.m. for Board of Equalization and reconvened at 9:02 a.m.

Robertson discussed the Attorney General Opinion for Assessors that was recently released regarding land assessment.

We have received two bids for a ADA Accessible door for the Annex and are waiting for at least one more bid.

Dennis Miller gave hospital updates on the financial status, pharmacy and possible new services.

Motion was made by Krauter, seconded by Krajewski to appoint Clint Robertson, Jeannie Schwartz, Sheri McCord, Gerald Frerichs, Michelle Arceo-Natera, Morgan Wiant, Randy Ross

and Sam Pedraza to the Grievance Board. Roll call vote: Yeas: Krajewski, Dymak, Krauter.
Nays: 0. Motion carried.

Dymak adjourned the meeting at 9:38 a.m.

The next regular board meeting will be held Monday, August 9, 2025 at 8:30 a.m.
