The Board of the County Commissioners in and for Garden County, Nebraska, met on December 22, 2025 at the Garden County Courthouse for their regular meeting, pursuant to statute. Notice of the regular meeting and Board of Equalization were given in advance by publication in the Garden County News on December 17, 2025. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the public.

Chairman Dymak called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. with the following members present: David Dymak, Dixann Krajewski and Terry Krauter.

Dymak acknowledged that the Open Meeting Laws are posted on the meeting room wall along with the Garden County Board Meeting Guidelines. Pledge of Allegiance was said.

Motion was made by Krauter, seconded by Krajewski, to approve the consent agenda, which includes Agenda, Minutes of last regular meeting and Board of Equalization held December 8, 2025, claims and payroll by general consent and allow the County Clerk to issue warrants in payment of the claims and payroll. A copy of which is on file in the office of the County Clerk. Roll call vote: Yeas: Dymak, Krauter, Krajewski. Nays: 0. Motion carried.

Commissioner Report: Krajewski attended the NACO Conference and gave updates on the sessions.

Public Comment: None.

Ross gave the Sheriff Report. Schutkowski will be attending the Training Center in January. Ross also updated the board on the Carl Thomas case.

Leach gave the Transportation Report.

Frerichs gave the Road Report.

Kezar, J. Robertson, C. Robertson, McCord, Krajewski, Frerichs and Blake attended the Nebraska Association of County Officials Conference in Kearney, Nebraska.

Motion was made by Krajewski, seconded by Krauter to approve lowering the Lisco Bridge Weight Limit to 10 ton effective immediately. A resolution will follow at the next board meeting on January 12, 2026. Roll call vote: Yeas: Krauter, Dymak, Krajewski. Nays: 0. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Krajewski, seconded by Krauter to approve Resolution 2025-12-1 to set the salaries for the Garden County Elected Officials taking office in 2027. Roll call vote: Yeas: Krajewski, Krauter, Dymak. Nays: 0. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Krauter, seconded by Dymak to approve \$50,033.70 be taken from Tribal Funds for Road Department expenditures (millings). Roll call vote: Yeas: Dymak, Krajewski, Krauter. Nays: 0. Motion carried.

Commissioner salary discussion was held. Nebraska Statute 23-1114 states that no county board member's salary shall be increased more than once every two fiscal years. The board salaries for 2026 will not increase as stated in Resolution 2021-12-3.

Pennington discussed the lab agreement and gave an update on the hospital.

Dymak adjourned the meeting at 10:13 a.m.

The next regular board meeting and reorganizational meeting will be held Monday, January 12, 2025 at 8:30 a.m.
