The Board of the County Commissioners in and for Garden County, Nebraska, met on November 10, 2025 at the Garden County Courthouse for their regular meeting, pursuant to statute. Notice of the regular meeting and Board of Equalization meeting was given in advance by publication in the Garden County News on November 5, 2025. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the public.

Chairman Dymak called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. with the following members present: Dixann Krajewski and David Dymak. Terry Krauter was absent

Dymak acknowledged that the Open Meeting Laws are posted on the meeting room wall along with the Garden County Board Meeting Guidelines. Pledge of Allegiance was said.

Motion was made by Krajewski, seconded by Dymak, to approve the consent agenda, which includes Agenda, Minutes of last regular meeting, Board of Equalization Minutes, claims and payroll by general consent and allow the County Clerk to issue warrants in payment of the claims and payroll. A copy of which is on file in the office of the County Clerk. Roll call vote: Yeas: Dymak, Krajewski. Nays: 0. Motion carried.

Public Comment: Teresa McCormick discussed elections.

Fornander gave the Sheriff report. They are working on two new deputy hires. The Board also discussed using the Inheritance Fund as a loan to pay for the Sheriff body cameras to avoid interest.

Leach gave Transit updates.

Dymak gave the Road report.

Motion was made by Dymak, seconded by Krajewski to approve Resolution 2025-11-3 for the Transportation Price Policy update (Public Hearing held October 27, 2025). Roll call vote: Yeas: Krajewski, Dymak. Nays: 0. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Krajewski, seconded by Dymak to approve Resolution 2025-11-1 for payment of Longevity Pay on November 24, 2025. Roll call vote: Yeas: Krajewski, Dymak. Nays: 0. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Dymak, seconded by Krajewski to approve the MOU with Nebraska Department of Veterans Affairs. Roll call vote: Yeas: Krajewski, Dymak. Nays: 0. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Krajewski, seconded by Dymak to approve Resolution 2025-11-2 to transfer \$2,000.00 from the General Fund to the Juvenile Justice Fund in accordance with the 2025-2026 Fiscal Year Budget requests and lid limitation laws. Roll call vote: Yeas: Dymak, Krajewski. Nays: 0. Motion carried.

The Lab Agreement with Garden County Health District was discussed.

The Board and Department Heads discussed salary options.

Dymak adjourned the meeting at 11:13 a.m.

The next regular board meeting will be held Monday, November 24, 2025 at 8:30 a.m.
